ABOUT TOBY THREADGILL

Toby Threadgill began his martial arts training in western fencing with USN Capt. Hart Kait. In 1980 he began training in Wado-ryu karate under J.Gerry Chau. This training led him to investigate other systems of martial arts. In 1985 Toby Threadgill was introduced to Yuki Yoshi Takamura, headmaster Takamura ha Shindo Yoshin ryu.

In 1986 he was offered membership in the Shindo Yoshin Kai personally by headmaster Takamura. He brings with him a wealth of knowledge and insight into martial arts in general, and classical Japanese bujutsu in particular. Threadgill Sensei is one of only three people in the world to be awarded a menkyo kaiden (license of full transmission) in Takamura-ha Shindo Yoshin-ryu. He presently functions as the kaicho (administrative head) of the Takamura ha Shindo Yoshin Kai worldwide and oversees instruction at the Takamura ha Shindo Yoshin Kai Hombu Dojo.

ABOUT SHINDO YOSHIN RYU

Shindo Yoshin ryu is a Nihon Koryu tradition founded by a Kuroda Clan retainer, Katsunotsuke Matsuoka in 1864. It combines the lineages of Akiyama

Yoshin ryu, Nakamura Yoshin Koryu, Hokushin Itto ryu and Jikishinkage ryu. The Takamura ryuha includes further influence from Matsuzaki Shinkage ryu Hyoho.

Initially characterized by an aggressive, almost predatory, hard jujutsu syllabus, TSYR includes at its highest levels a series of teachings identified as myoden. These techniques are a study in subtly of movement, tactile sensitivity and psychological manipulation. Extremely soft in application these waza exploit various sensory mechanisms in the quest of maximizing physical efficiency. In the past these elements of the art were considered secret and not demonstrated openly. However, Takamura Sensei, believed that continued efforts to keep these tactics obscure risked their eventual neglect or loss. For this reason he decided to begin demonstrating and teaching selected myoden waza in public forums.
